If all stays on schedule, I will complete the final dose of my chemo medicine on Star Wars Day. I am lucky that my cancer was caught early and only requires one round of chemotherapy.

Elizabeth continues her support, for which I am very greatful. We are looking forward to having one of our two kids home for Christmas. That will give Elizabeth a break from work and someone else to spoil, other than me.

I hope to see you on the dance floor soon, and remember Never Stop Dancing.
